

Home Visits

- Home Visit (no charge)

• For a home visit during normal hours there are no charge for the visit besides the services rendered during the visit.

Weekend Home Visit (+\$400)

- Visit Includes a +\$400 Weekend Fee applied to the Service bill.
- Applies to visits scheduled on Saturday and Sundays

- After-hours Home Visit (+\$250)

- Include +\$250 After-hour fee applied to the Service Bill for visits on weeknights.
- o Applies to visits with scheduled start times 5:30-8:59pm on weeknights

Middle of the Night Home Visit (+\$500)

- Include +\$500 After-hour fee applied to the Service Bill for visits on weeknights.
 - o Applies to visits with scheduled start times 9:00pm-7:59am

- Add-Ons

- Establish Care with Physician (Includes Consulting, Physical Exam, and Treatment Plan) (\$300)
- Rapid Medical Assessment (\$160)
- Requesting Treatment Plan (Includes history taking, prescribing medications/supplements, lab/imaging ordering, sending of treatment to patient) (\$140)

Telemedicine

- Telemedicine Visit (New Patient—30-60 minutes) \$300
 - Telemedicine New Patient Appointments include taking a detailed medical history, reviewing previous medical records/labs/imaging, medication evaluation, and provide the patient with a comprehensive integrative treatment plan.
- Telemedicine (Follow Up Patient | 15-45 minutes) \$150
 - Telemedicine Follow up Appointments includes discussing pertinent health history changes since the previous visit, review recent lab work results, discuss health progress, and formulate a treatment plan.
- 15 Minute Consult (New Patient | 15 minutes) free
 - 15-minute consult for non-established patients to meet the physician and determine if they would like to establish as a patient.

Non-Visit Interaction

- E-mail/SMS Correspondence Initiated by Patient (Follow Up Patient | 15 minutes, \$45 | 30 minutes, \$75|)
 - Charges are for reading and evaluating the patient query, reviewing and analyzing the material necessary to determine the best and most reliable answer, and stating the answer in a way that will be understandable and meaningful to the patient. Includes one complete response email/SMS by the physician.
- Paperwork on behalf of the patient (Follow Up Patient | 30 minutes, \$75 |
 - Billable for the physician's time to complete forms for the patient; includes School forms, Camp forms, Sports participation forms, Disability forms, FMLA forms, Life insurance forms, Paperwork for patient assistance programs, Referral letters.
- Refills or prescription changes handled outside of an office visit (Follow Up Patient | \$75 |
 - Covers the physician's time for creating a medical encounter, filling out a prescription form, and interacting with the pharmacy.
- Imaging or lab order handled outside of an office visit (Follow Up Patient | \$75)
 - Covers the physician's time for creating a medical encounter, filling out a lab/imaging order form, and interacting with the lab/imaging center.

Intravenous Therapies

All Intravenous therapies are mixed within 45 minutes of administration in an ISO-5 Laminar Flow Hood within an ISO-7 environment to ensure USP Compliance.

- Acute Immunity IV \$250 500mL
 - Reserved for those battling an acute viral illness. The IV contains the maximum amount of Vitamin C allowable before lab testing is required. The IV is further bolstered with Lysine to inhibit viral replication, Zinc and Magnesium for immune support, B vitamins and B12 for energy. The IV is delivered and administered at your home by a physician.



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- Ingredients List: Ascorbic Acid (12500mg), B-Complex, Dexpanthenol (250mg), Magnesium Chloride (1200mg), Pyridoxine (100mg), Methyl + Hydroxy-B12 (1000mcg), Zinc Chloride (10mg), N-Acetyl-cysteine (400mg), Lysine (300mg), Selenium (200mcg), Thiamine (100mg)
- Drip time: 60 minutes for maximum substrate utilization

- MOAB (Mother of All Bags) \$360 1000mL

- The big brother of our acute immunity IV. Twice the size, with the maximum therapeutic dosages of the 11 included micronutrients. Reserved for our most ill patients.
 - Ingredients List: Ascorbic Acid (12500mg), B-Complex, Dexpanthenol (500mg), Magnesium Chloride (1600mg), Pyridoxine (200mg), Methyl + Hydroxy-B12 (2000mcg), Zinc Chloride (20mg), N-Acetyl-cysteine (600mg), Lysine (500mg), Selenium (400mcg), Thiamine (200mg)
 - Drip time: 90-120 minutes for maximum substrate utilization

- Glutathione (GSH) Detox Bag (Add-on)

- Potent antioxidant IV therapy. Pricing is based off of dosage which varies dependent upon intended effect.
 - 600mg—Gentle detox **\$30**
 - 800mg—Moderate detox \$40
 - 1000mg—Acute dosage (Rx Only) \$50 –most common dose when feeling sick
 - 1200mg Acute dosage (Rx Only) \$60
 - 1400mg—Acute dosage (Rx Only) \$70
 - 1600mg+ —Acute dosage (Rx Only) variable

- Nutrient Boost IV \$175 250mL

 Our signature nutrient bag combines Vitamin C, Magnesium, Zinc, an assortment of B vitamins, and concentrated B12 into a single 250ml bag of Sodium Chloride. This IV is designed for those needing a boost in energy and key nutrients that are often depleted in today's world. IV is administered in-home and takes approximately 35 minutes.

- Replenish & Rehydrate IV (\$250/500ml, \$340/1000ml)

- Dehydration is a common ailment in the desert. This IV provides the body with needed hydration directly into your veins. It comes with added minerals, magnesium, and B vitamins for energy added into a 500ml/1000ml lactated ringer's bag. Which size is best is dependent on body size, and severity of symptoms which can be determined during the assessment phase of the visit.
 - Ingredients List: Ascorbic Acid (5000mg), B-Complex, Dexpanthenol (500mg), Magnesium Chloride (1400mg), Pyridoxine (1500mg), Methyl + Hydroxy-B12 (2000mcg), Zinc Chloride (15mg), N-Acetylcysteine (400-600mg), Selenium (400mcg), Thiamine (200mg)
 - Drip time: 60-90 minutes for maximum substrate utilization

- Pregnancy-Friendly Replenish & Rehydrate IV (\$250/500ml, \$340/1000ml)

- A fetus-friendly IV designed to keep moms-to-be out of the ER when the morning sickness proves to be a bit too much. The exact IV formula is included below to provide to your OB.
 - Formula: Ascorbic Acid (Non-Corn) 500mg/ml 6ml, B-Complex 1.5ml, Total Cobalamins (B12) 1mg/ml 0.5ml, Zinc Chloride 10mg/ml 1ml, Folic Acid 10mg/ml 1ml, Magnesium Sulfate 25% 250mg/ml 3ml, Lactated Ringer (LR) 500 0 0.0275 137.5. Total mls: 513; Total mOsms: 183.095; Total Osmolarity: 357
 - Drip Time: 60-75 minutes for maximum substrate utilization

- Migraine Mender IV \$250/500mL, \$350/1000mL

• Well researched and directly formulated for the treatment of an aggressive migraine. Is the replenish and rehydrate bag but with high dosages of Pyridoxine (B5), folic acid, and magnesium which are all independently validated as a treatment for a migraine.



Intravenous NAD+ w/ Replenish & Rehydrate IV

- Intravenous administration of Nicotinamide-Adenine-Dinucleotide (NAD+) alongside a replenish and rehydrate
 500ml bag. Aimed at those with severe mitochondrial dysfunction (Chronic Fatigue, Fibromyalgia, Drug addiction, etc.) or those looking to prevent "aging."
 - 100mg \$400
 - 250mg **\$600**
 - 500mg \$800 (Rx Only)
 - 1000mg \$1,200 (Rx Only)
 - 5-day "Drug of Abuse" Withdrawal/Detox Protocol \$7,200

- Alpha Lipoic Acid (ALA) + Replenish & Rehydrate (double bag) IV

- Intravenous Administration of Alpha-Lipoic Acid (ALA), a fat & water-soluble potent antioxidant, along with a second bag of all its nutrient cofactors. Formula is designed to assist in the repair of parts of the body where water-soluble antioxidants like glutathione have difficulty reaching, such as nerves and neurons.
- Usages include but are not limited:
 - Repairing neuronal damage secondary to autoimmune mediated conditions such as Parkinson's, and MS.
 - Treating peripheral neuropathies secondary to such conditions as *uncontrolled* diabetes, and chemotherapy treatment.
 - Assisting the liver in recovering from Alcoholic & Non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD).
- Dosages:
 - 50mg ALA + Replenish & Rehydrate \$320
 - 100mg ALA + Replenish & Rehydrate \$340
 - 250mg ALA + Replenish & Rehydrate \$360
 - 500mg ALA + Replenish & Rehydrate \$400 (Rx Only)

- Intravenous Heavy Metal Chelation (Rx Only) \$400

- Triple bag IV for heavy metal chelation (Calcium-EDTA, followed by DMPS, followed by Glutathione). IVs are adapted to patient's weight, kidney function, and specific heavy metal body burden. Requirements include documented heavy metal toxicity via Urinary Toxic Metal Screening (UTM), recent CBC w/Diff, CMP; and Urinalysis lab results
- o Based on the specifics of your case the physician may require that you establish care.

- Iron Infusion (Venofer) IV (Rx Only) \$720 Initial (<250mg) / \$450 Subsequent (<250mg)

- Iron Infusion to correct iron deficiency where oral supplementation has failed.
- **Requires Rx** from an outside provider with lab work and letter of referral, or the patient must be established with an Elixir Clinic Physician.

Intramuscular Injections

- B12 Energy Booster Shot \$20

• B12 and B Complex combined into 1 shot to give you added energy.

- Vitamin D Injection (\$25/25,000IU, \$30/50,000IU)

o Intramuscular injection of Vitamin D to quickly correct deficiencies in the chronic or acute immune setting

- Zofran (ondansetron) Injection \$30

o Intramuscular injection of anti-nausea medication to decrease nausea/vomiting.

- NAD+ (Nicotinamide-Adenine-Dinucleotide) Injection (\$60/25mg, \$90/50mg)



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 Intramuscular injection of NAD+ to assist with in a variety of important cellular processes, including energy production, metabolism, and DNA repair.

Nebulization

- Nebulized Glutathione Treatment (Add-on) \$30
 - Administration of glutathione (GSH) directly to the alveolar surface of the lungs via nebulization for the intended purpose of reducing oxidative stress and damage to the lung parenchyma, while concurrently cleaving mucus to make a dry cough more productive.

Laboratory Testing

- Laboratory testing draw free (\$120)
 - Cost to have the physician come and collect samples for laboratory testing and then drop them off at the respective lab for processing. Price does not include the cost of the labs themselves. We can provide estimates on total cost dependent on what tests need to be run.
